

**A Resolution of the Commissioners' Court
of
Kendall County, Texas
April 9, 2007**

Whereas: Kendall County has been declared a Priority Groundwater Management Area (PGMA) by the Texas Commission of Environmental Quality (TCEQ), and

Whereas: The orderly development of the area and our watersheds is of concern not only to Kendall County, but to all counties that are within a PGMA, and

Whereas: Without adequate development regulations, these areas may be developed in ways that endanger public water supplies and interfere with the proper use of the area to the detriment of the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare, and

Whereas: Representative Patrick Rose of District 45 has introduced HB 3447, on behalf of all counties that lie within a PGMA, that would empower those counties, including Kendall County, to adequately plan and manage future growth within the boundaries of a PGMA

Therefore: The Commissioners' Court of Kendall County pray to the honorable members of the 80th Legislature of the Great Republic of Texas to use your powers, and influence to ensure that HB 3447 becomes the law of our great state.
