Contested Case Hearing Request Checklist

TCEQ requires a list of specific information before granting “affected person” status in a contested case hearing. **If you do not include every single one of these items in your request letter, TCEQ will likely deny your request.**

For families, we recommend a separate hearing request for each person in your household, including children.

- Your name
- Your mailing address
- Your daytime telephone number
- Permit number: **147392L001**
- Applicant’s name: **Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC**
- Statement clearly requesting a **contested case hearing**
- Location of your home, business, or other property that is affected
- Distance from the proposed facility to your home, business, or other property
- Detailed explanation of how you or your property would be adversely affected by the proposed facility in a manner not common to the general public
- List of all the relevant disputed issues of fact, or questions of fact and law—especially issues that you raised in your public comments to TCEQ at or before the February public meeting

You may submit your hearing request by mail, online, or both. We recommend submitting **both by mail and online** to avoid any potential technical errors or delays.

1. Go to <http://www.tceq.texas.gov/goto/comments>
2. Click the Comment Online button
3. In the Permit Number box, enter 147392L001, click Next
4. Complete the comment form, click Submit to TCEQ
