Measuring Your Distance from the Proposed Quarry

In your contested case hearing request, you must include the distance from the proposed facility to your home, business, or other affected property. We recommend measuring and including **both** your distance from the nearest property fence line and your distance from the proposed crusher location.

Do not use driving directions to measure your distance: this will artificially inflate your distance from the quarry site.

To measure your exact distance to the crusher “as the crow flies,” follow these steps (using a computer, not a mobile device):

1. Go to stop3009vulcanquarry.com/crushermap (you'll be redirected to a Google Map pinning the proposed crusher location).
2. Zoom and move the map until you see your property. Right-click/context-click your property location, then select **Measure distance**.
3. If necessary, zoom and move the map until the red crusher pin is visible. Click the point of the crusher pin. Your distance will be shown.

Measuring your exact distance to the fence line will be easy if you are located to the north or east of the quarry location: just measure to the closest point of Texas Highway 46 or FM 3009 using the measurement tool described above.

If you are located to the west or south of the proposed quarry, finding the fence line is a little more difficult. You may want to switch to satellite mode and/or consult the maps on www.stop3009vulcanquarry.com.
